He attended Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam. Greg has performed with numerous Hudson Valley groups, including The Last Chance Jazz Band, Mosaic, and The Red Wing Blackbirds. Currently, he performs with the Rhinebeck Legion Band (since 2021), The Bearcats Jazz Band, Northern Dutchess Symphony Orchestra, the Saugerties Community Band and the Kingston Rotary Band. Greg retired from Vassar College after 31 years of employment.

*Zachary Povall (Guest Conductor) ... has played clarinet and bass clarinet with the Rhinebeck Legion Band since 2016. He holds a B.M. in Music Education from SUNY Fredonia and is pursuing an M.P.S. in Social Justice Education studies from SUNY New Paltz. Zach teaches Band at Marlboro Elementary School and Directs the Marlboro High School Drama Club Productions. He also enjoys writing music and has begun self-publishing his works with J.W. Pepper, including "Pulse of Triumph," premiered by the Rhinebeck Legion Band in 2024.

Noah Shulman (Tuba Soloist) ... joined the Rhinebeck Legion Band in 2022. He began playing brass instruments at age 5 and literally grew into playing tuba as his primary instrument. Originally from Pittsburgh, PA, Noah studied privately with Phil Vanouse and played with numerous groups, including the Pittsburgh Youth Symphony Orchestra and the River City Youth Brass Band. He currently studies privately with Alec Mawrence and plays with the Woodstock Symphony Orchestra.

Connie Kessel (Conductor) is principal flutist of the Northern Dutchess Symphony Orchestra. She also performs with the Vassar College & Community Wind Ensemble, the Hudson Valley Flute Ensemble and is active in the area as a free-lance musician and private flute teacher. Connie holds a B.M. from SUNY Fredonia and an M.M. from Western Michigan University. She taught band & music for 31 years in the Pine Plains Central School District.

The Rhinebeck Legion Band ... was founded in the early 1920's and has been in continuous existence ever since. The band has an active performance schedule in the Dutchess County area including occasional local events as well as regular summer concert series for the Town of Rhinebeck and Red Hook.
